What license you need	What you can tow	Total vehicle weight
Class 8 – Tractors Only	<i>Not Allowed</i>	<i>14 000kg or LESS</i>
Class 8 + passed tractor safety course	<i>4500 kg or LESS</i>	<i>14 000kg or LESS</i>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be 16 years of age or 14 years of age with Parental approval. • Pass a vision screening test and written rules and signs test. • Medical and optical reports may be required. 	
CLASS 8 LICENSE & TOW IMPLEMENTS	
<p>For Class 8 license and to be able to tow implements on highways:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Be 16 years of age or 14 years of age with Parental approval. 2. Pass a vision screening test and written rules and signs test. 3. Medical and optical reports may be required. 4. Take the Tractor Safety Course offered by Extended Learning and Dalhousie Faculty of Agriculture. (https://www.dal.ca/faculty/agriculture/extended-learning.html) <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Upon successful completion of this course, you will receive a wallet card proving completion, allowing you to drive a tractor pulling farm implements with a combined weight up to 14,000 kg, with no restriction on the towed implement weight. 5.
